Bonnie Lindsay has navigated through three major careers in her lifetime: nursing, technology, and management consulting. She was a Registered Nurse for 12 years, primarily working in critical care areas (ICU, CCU). She returned to school to study information technology and began her second career as a programmer, progressing rapidly to analyst and manager in a number of industries.

In 1996, Bonnie again returned to school and graduated from the University of Ottawa Executive MBA Program in 1998. She began working for **IT/NET** shortly afterwards. During her first year she earned the Certified Management Consultant (CMC) designation, placing 13th in Canada and number one in Ottawa. She became a partner in the firm in 2001. Her primary focus, aside from actually doing consulting work for clients, has been in standardization and consistency in all areas of the business – proposal writing, managing the delivery process, and developing customer deliverables.
